Grouper and Kuali Rice

- Grouper
 - Define Groups once and use with multiple applications
 - Manage from One Location
 - Distribute Control
- Kuali Rice
 - Provides Identity and Access Management services as part of Kuali Identity Management
 - Group, Identity, Permission, etc. services
 - Management interfaces



Why connect Rice to Grouper?

- Already use Grouper
- Want richer group model
- Add workflow to Grouper
- Quickstart integration to IdM
- ... because we said we would make it happen after last year's Advance CAMP!




Where does Grouper fit into KIM?

- The primary goal of KIM was to build a serviceoriented abstraction layer for Identity and Access Management
- Provides leverage via these common service contracts to all applications built on Kuali technology
- Integration with other identity and access management services was acknowledged, expected, and designed for!




Where does Grouper fit into KIM?

How to connect Rice to Grouper?

- Add two jars to Rice (grouperRice.jar and grouperClient.jar)
- Add / configure grouper.client.properties
- Configure Rice spring override to group and/or identity service
- Setup a Grouper folder for the "Rice root"
