InCommon has introduced two new online education series and is now the sponsor of the CAMP (Campus Architecture and Middleware Planning).

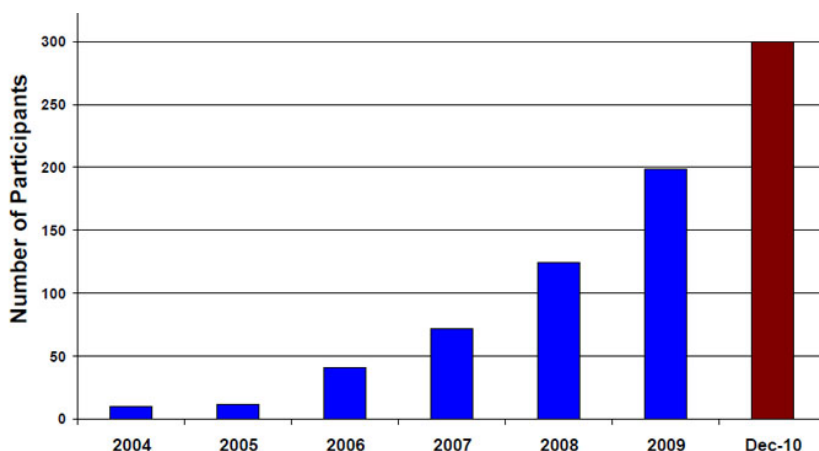
