Background: In the biomedical research and medical education domain, we are working with groups like NCI, CDC, and the Global Virus Network (GVN) to support international collaboration and virtual organizations. We joined the Open Health Tools response to an RFI from NCI, and we are working with Anil Srivastava and the Open Health Systems Lab on a "Cancer Commons." Meanwhile, Patrick Soon-Shiong has announced plans to invest \$100 million in NLR and to launch a project to address "the war against cancer and the enormous potential of molecular, evidence-based personalized medicine."

Background: Rural health care networks in six states have connected to the Internet2 Network and seven more are in the pipeline. With approximately one thousand health care providers now connected to the Internet2 backbone, we are in a position to work with third-party service providers to offer products and services to this community of advanced network users. Three additional clusters of early adopters of advanced networking are in Kansas, the Upper Midwest, and the mid-Atlantic region. We have recently hired an intern to work with the Upper Midwest Health Group to jump-start documentation use cases.
