Business Models

- Primary Focus of 2nd Quilt/InCommon Workshop Feb 2014
- Models essentially came down to the amount of work a Regional was willing to do on behalf of InCommon, and/or their constituents
- Registration Authority Model InC ½ of the equation
- Steward Model —> Soup-to-Nuts
 - Organizational Vetting
 - Metadata Management (Testing, Manual Review, etc.)
 - IdP Management/Hosting
 - Represent Constituents within InCommon



Steward Model Pilot

- Defined responsibilities of the Steward and InCommon (Term Sheets)
- Reviewed existing documents and proposed changes to support the model
- Created "new" documents (Steward Addendum, Cost Model with deliverables for both sides)
- Provided updated documents to InCommon Steering
- Currently being reviewed by InCommon Legal
