Target Constituents:

- K12 Organizations

Initial Goals:

- Implement a federated service
- Federate an internal service
- Share benefits of federation with K20 community
- Get K20 community excited about federated ID



Merit Michigan ID:

- Announced in May 2012
- Michigan-focused federation
- Optional Hosted Identity Provider service
- Looking for additional Service Providers





Targeted Services:

- Offered Merit Cloud Media (aka NJVID)
- Canvas
- Merit-Hosted IdP High Availability



Plan to generate interest:


- Two sessions at the 2013 Member Conference:

Member Interest:

- Low; federated identity not seen as high priority
- Short-staffed, unavailable for pilot
- Excitement at Member Conference, then tapered off


Lake Michigan College:

 - Canvas unable to federate with Merit Michigan ID
- High availability authentication
 - Merit-Hosted IdP
- Higher priorities arose, unable to participate
- Still has vision of shared, federated services amongst
 Michigan community colleges



Need to Recruit Members!

- Sustained marketing
- More Member outreach
- Available Service Offerings
- Needed an Influencer
- More education?
