

Sign up for **EMERGENCY** cell phone notification



Purdue University will be conducting a
**TEST OF AN EMERGENCY TEXT MESSAGING ALERT
SYSTEM ON MONDAY SEPTEMBER 24 AT 11:25 A.M.** to
notify members of the Purdue community in the event
of a campus emergency.

Purdue students, faculty, and staff who want to **TAKE PART IN THE TEST** should register their cell phone number.

Go to <http://www.purdue.edu/securepurdue>, click on the “Change My Password” icon, enter your career account name and password, and then select the “Emergency Contact Information” link. Enter your cell phone number in the space provided.

Purdue will send text messages to your cell phone only in the event of a public safety emergency or a well-publicized test of the emergency notification systems. The University will use this information for no other purpose. Depending on your cell phone plan, your carrier may charge you for receiving these text messages.

Please consider registering so Purdue has more options for contacting you in the unlikely event of such an emergency.
