

Worlds for Internet Technology and Science


- Funded by the National Science Foundation
 - Broadening Participation in Computing
- Take the SciFair Model developed at the Cornell Theory Center and expand its application and adapt/adopt the community service mentoring
- GST BOCES, UCSD, VCU, PSU each program different
- Potential for undergraduate service learning





Southern Tier SciFair

- Founded at Cornell with regional schools
- Supported by a regional career track consortium
- Adopted by NYS regional service provider
 - GST BOCES
- Extends across NYS through Distance Learning
 Cooperative Services system longterm



CyberCiv

- 6th Grade Social Studies
 - Sequence of Ancient Civilization worlds
 - Created by undergraduate designers with professional educator staff guidance and input from teachers
 - Funded through a NYSED 3-year grant
 - Modular and adaptable
 - Designed for integrated Language Arts and Social Studies standards
 - Builds Computer Tech Literacy (learning.com 8th grade assessment for ISTE NETS for Students)

 - Hosted in Cuni and supported by undergraduate engineer mentor/tech coordinator

- Course Module for Engineering Ethics
 - Provide neutral and engaging environment
 - Design experiment funded through Cornell's Faculty Innovation program (CIT)
 - SciCentr Staff/Ethics Faculty/CIT MM designer/ undergraduate researcher, modeler, world builder
 - NPC bot for interaction and rich content
