Primary Challenges

INTERNET

- 1. Impact of Globalization
  - Global enrollment has doubled in 20 years
  - 160 American universities overseas
  - 3 million students study from home
  - Need to be in the global business
- 2. Changing Nature of Science and Research to Large-Scale, Distributed Projects
  - Example: Large Hadron Collider
  - Cost of research requires partners
  - More and more alliances with other universities around the world (Michael McRobbie, President, Indiana University)
- 3. Impact of For-Profit Providers
  - Demand for education not being met by traditional institutions alone

- Primary Challenges (continued)
  - 4. Lifelong Learning Increasing the Critical Role of Community and Vocational Colleges
    - Accessibility and affordability
      - Lowers costs to students
      - Brings education to the community
  - 5. Impact of Decreased Public Funding for Universities and the Increased Cost of Education
    - Role of vocational and community colleges
    - Solutions need better end-to-end infrastructure
  - 6. Risk Management and Business Resiliency Requirements
    - Higher education is a business. If our business delivery is not resilient, the student will go elsewhere
    - Examples: Impact of Katrina



- Community Ecosystem
  - NRENs are complicated
  - Decisions made at one level affect all levels
