




Oman's research vision is to become the research hub for water, energy, downstream petrochemicals, and agro / marine biotechnology...






Information Technology strategy fully align with TRC strategy phases



TRC has invested significant resources to create services and applications to assist researchers, innovators, students, general public, etc











OMREN Strategic Focus








Geography & Demographics segmentation of OMREN; Potential stakeholders and infrastructure providers capabilities view






High Level Technical Model





Managed Services Infrastructure






OMREN Organization and Governance Models Framework
