






Interconnecting Arab States National R&E Networks


- Regional connectivity of Arab NREN's is essential to future growth

Cable status as of september 2012

- SMW-4 had 1.62TBps lit at the end of 2011; 2012 upgrades will increase potential capacity to 4.8 Tbps
- IMEWE in service since december 2010 has 730Gbps lit capacity and a design capacity of 3.84Tbps
- TGN-EA Mumbai Marseille in service since end 2011.
- TGN-Gulf in service since february 2012; lit capacity of 160gbps, design capacity of 2.56Tbps
- GBI is partially in service since february 2012 with 170gbps initial capacity (lit part not public) and 2.56Tbps design capacity.
- FLAG FALCON operational since 2006 now has 520 gbps capacity upgradeable to 6.4Tbps
- EIG: Egypt part completed in january 2012, whole system now operational
- MENA: RFS sheduled for Q4 2012 (will link GBI)
- RCN is life since august (unprotected mode)


