Today we reviewed the NPRM comments document titled "09.06.2010." The change history below describes the sections with changes. I have attached a revised document ("...09.07.2010.pdf") that includes these edits. If you find any typos or errors let me know by noon tomorrow. We will continue to polish the document before submitting it tomorrow afternoon (Sept. 8th).

## **CHANGE HISTORY**

- Alan noted that comment documents longer than 10 pages should have a Summary or Introduction and Summary section and a Table of Contents section. They will be added.
- At least four participants on the call noted the frequent use of the word "must" and all agreed that it should be replaced throughout with "should" or "we strongly recommend."
- "Health care" will replace "healthcare" throughout.
- "The Commission" will replace "FCC" or "the FCC" throughout.
- In "General Comments" an extra period at the end of the 3rd bullet was removed.

- In section #9b the language about keeping materials private was refined.
- In section #9f "a line item basis" was changed to "a category basis."
- In section #9g an orphan quote mark was removed.
- In section #14 a recommendation was added against excluding projects unable to meet the 10mbps minimum due to technology or financial constraints.
- In recommendation #14.1 (now 14.2) two instances of "backbone" were changed to "broadband."
- In Recommendation 16.0 (changed to 16.1) the first sentence was clarified and the paragraph truncated after the second sentence.
- In section #49 "lead" was changed to "led" in the last sentence.
- The entire section #92 was removed.
- In section #141 The NPRM asks about creating a working group to provide input to the FCC. We are adding a comment supporting the formation of such a workgroup.
