- Highlights of the Discussion
  - Integration of external identities is possible within a particular service provider, or within an institutional IdMS
  - There are different types of linking.
    - No linking. Identities received from different identity providers appear to be different people.
    - Link external credentials to an existing person record. People can use different authentication methods, but their attributes are maintained via local processes.
    - Merge attributes. Attributes other than credentials are merged from external identity providers.
