These are bullets points from the Panel Discussion.

- We need to find a way to flip and use the fact that we are decentralized, remote and distributed to help us with governance
- EA needs to define core vs. commodity (or at least help people figure this out).
- EA needs to focus on change management: culture and educational change
- Functions of EA: Facilitate, Navigate and Educate
- Be specific about the behaviors we are trying to affect
- Need to educate about the Connections and Dependencies
- Not regulate but embrace the diversity
- Governance should be tiered - related to the PACE Layers
- Use, Leverage and and Understand the different paradigms that exist on campus (e.g. Linda's paradigm is around pedagogy and learning outcomes not technology).
- Keep the importance of the user perspective at the fore
- Communicating as an EA: Keep the layers in mind - Conceptual -> Logical -> Physical
 - Understand the value proposition of the audience.
